## Student Insurance Enrollment and Waivers for SPRING 2020

North Carolina Central University students meeting specific eligibility criteria are required to have health insurance. The University sponsored student insurance plan is Blue Cross Blue Shield Student Blue Coverage.

### To Enroll – The BCBSNC enrollment must be completed by January 31, 2020

Eligibility Requirements: All three criteria must be met to be eligible for the student insurance

- Undergraduate/Graduate Students must be degree seeking and;
- Enrolled in six or more credit hours on the main campus (on-campus classes, in a classroom) and;
- Eligible to pay the medical fee.

If all three criteria are not met you are not eligible for the student insurance plan

- You will automatically be billed for Student Blue coverage unless you waive coverage by **January 31, 2020**. If you have your own plan, make sure you waive Student Blue coverage by that date. All students who meet the eligibility requirement criteria will be automatically billed for the Student Health Insurance Plan for the current semester. The charge for the insurance premium is included in the student tuition and fees bill.
- Eligible students who wish to keep the student insurance MUST enroll. Please visit [www.studentbluenc.com](http://www.studentbluenc.com) to enroll.
- Eligible students MUST enroll to ensure they have health insurance coverage by the first day of classes. If you do not ENROLL you will not be covered!

Distance Education/Online students ONLY are not eligible for the student insurance plan and WILL NOT BE CHARGED.

If you have enrolled in the insurance plan, and if at any time your credit hours drop below 6 credit hours on the main campus (on-campus, in a classroom) eligibility requirement, your enrollment will be VOIDED and you will no longer be covered under the University's sponsored Health Insurance Plan.

**To Waive – Waivers must be completed by January 31, 2020**

- Students who have their own credible medical insurance plan can waive (decline, opt-out) the student insurance plan.
- It is the students responsibility to complete an online insurance waiver each semester by visiting [www.studentblueinc.com](http://www.studentblueinc.com)
- This process must be done in order for the waiver credit to be applied to the student's bill
- Already covered under another Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina plan and want to keep it? You'll still need to waive the Student Blue coverage each university semester, or you will be charged for it.

**The deadline to process a student insurance waiver is January 31, 2020.**
