SOARING EAGLE

1180 SAT / 25 ACT
3.75 GPA = \$7,500



RISING EAGLE

1160 SAT / 24 ACT
3.5 GPA = \$3,500



EAGLE-IN-FLIGHT

1130 SAT / 23 ACT
3.2 GPA = \$2,500

📋 EXPECTATIONS

- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of:

3.25	3.0	3.0
Soaring Eagle	Rising Eagle	Eagle-In-Flight
- Enroll full-time each semester and earn a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester.
- Perform 15 hours of community service each semester.
- Reside in university housing for your first two years enrolled.
- File the FAFSA on October 1 of each year.
