

# Student Orientation & Registration (SOAR)

## Step by Step Student Guide



### Step 1

Register for Student Orientation & Registration (SOAR). Please visit <https://www.nccu.edu/life-nc-central/soar> and click “Enroll Now.”

You will choose the June 1 – August 3 date, which is a registration window. Please note that **ALL** in person sessions in June and July are cancelled. The dates June 1 – August 3<sup>rd</sup> indicates a window of time for which you should complete Steps 1 -4.

**Completing each step as soon as possible is highly encouraged.**

Upon registering, you will see a \$0 registration amount as the \$225 cost of orientation will be deferred and placed on your Fall 2020 student bill.

### Step 2

Complete your “Pre-Orientation Modules.” Your modules are **required** before you can meet with an academic advisor and receive your course schedule.

Please use your NCCU log-in credentials (the credentials you used to create your MyEOL account) to access the online modules.

### Step 3

All students that registered for SOAR **before** May 27<sup>th</sup> **AND** complete their modules by June 26<sup>th</sup>, can expect to receive communication from an Academic Advisor regarding your Fall 2020 course schedule, the week of June 29<sup>th</sup>.

All students that registered for SOAR **after** May 27<sup>th</sup> **AND** complete their modules by July 24<sup>th</sup>, can expect to receive communication from an Academic Advisor regarding your Fall 2020 course schedule, the week of July 27<sup>th</sup>.

### Step 4

The Office of New Student and Family programs will be hosting online webinars during the month of July. Information about specific dates and times, as well as how to access the webinars will be sent to your NCCU email during the last week of June.

### Step 5

The Office of New Student and Family Programs will host an In-person SOAR, August 17-21, 2020. In order to attend the in-person session, you must complete Steps 1-4.

*Please note that the in-person sessions do not take the place of steps 1-4.*

Students will not have to register for the in-person session as all new students will be on campus by this time and would have moved in to their assigned residential hall.
