SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Winston-Salem Chapter of North Carolina Central University Alumni Association awards scholarships each year to deserving youth. In order to be eligible for consideration, students must meet the criteria listed below.

I. ELIGIBILITY

In order to be considered for a scholarship, a student must:

- Be a resident of Winston Salem NC and Forsyth County
- Be a high school graduating senior
- Have applied, been accepted to NCCU and anticipate enrolling for the fall term

II. SELECTION PROCESS

Individuals receiving the scholarships will be selected on the basis of merit by the Scholarship Committee. The criteria to be taken into consideration include:

- Cumulative overall grade point average (minimum of 3.0 unweighted)
- SAT or ACT scores
- Extracurricular activities (school and community)
- Student responses during a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- The letter of acceptance from NCCU
- A copy of his/her high school transcript
- Relationship to NCCU Alumni members (A student's parent who is a financially active alumnus will be given preferential consideration, if the student meets all requirements).

III. DEADLINE

IV. INTERVIEW

Individual interviews may be conducted by the Scholarship Committee in April yearly.
