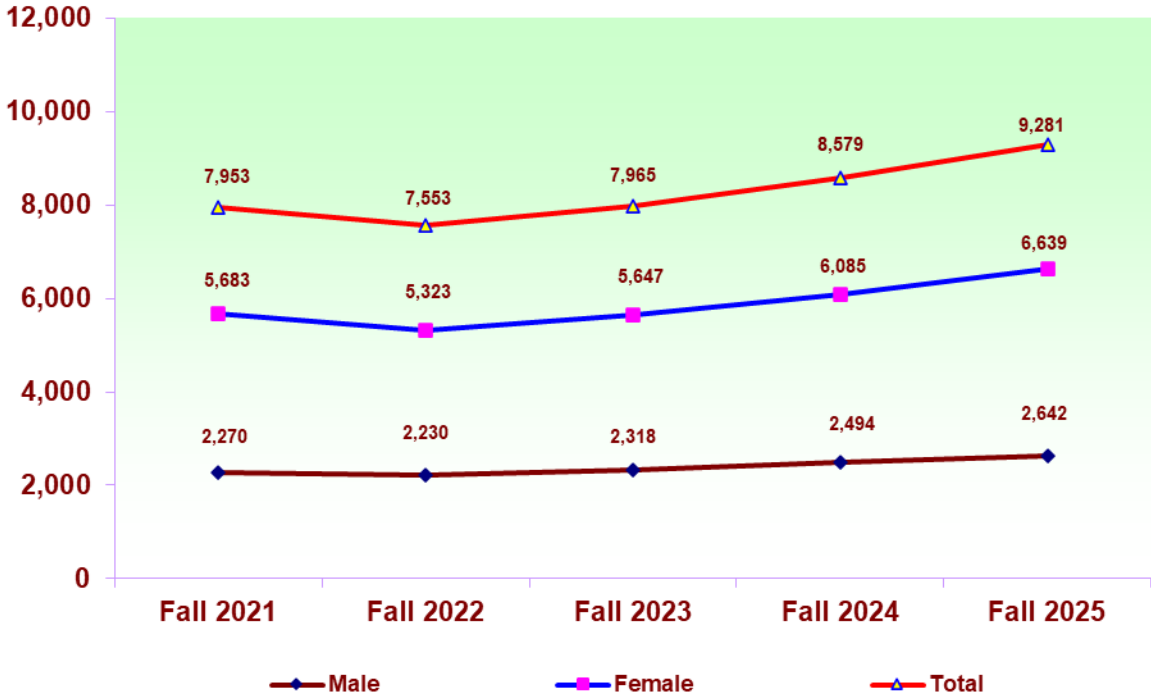

Student Enrollment Headcount by Gender

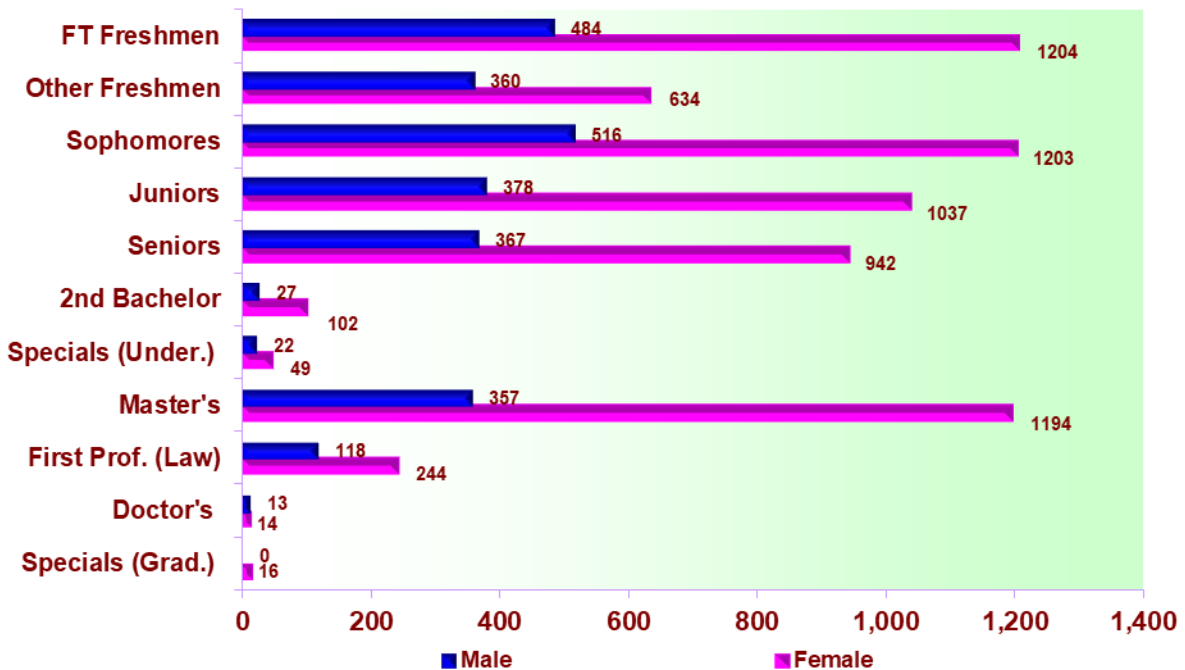

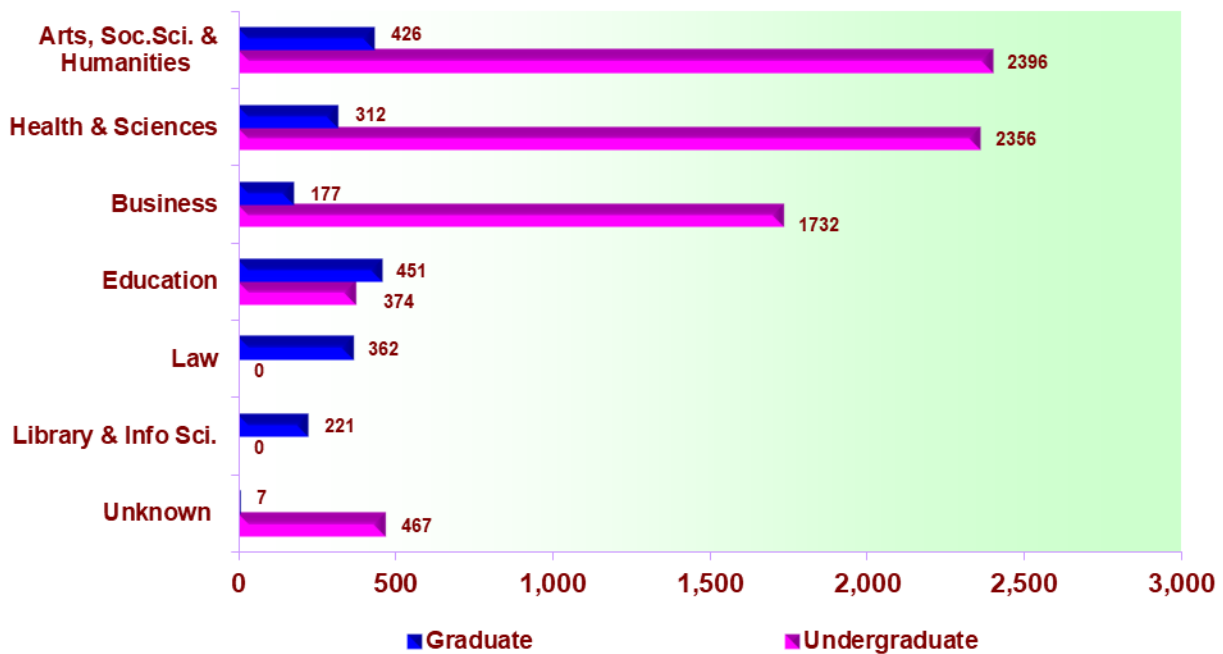

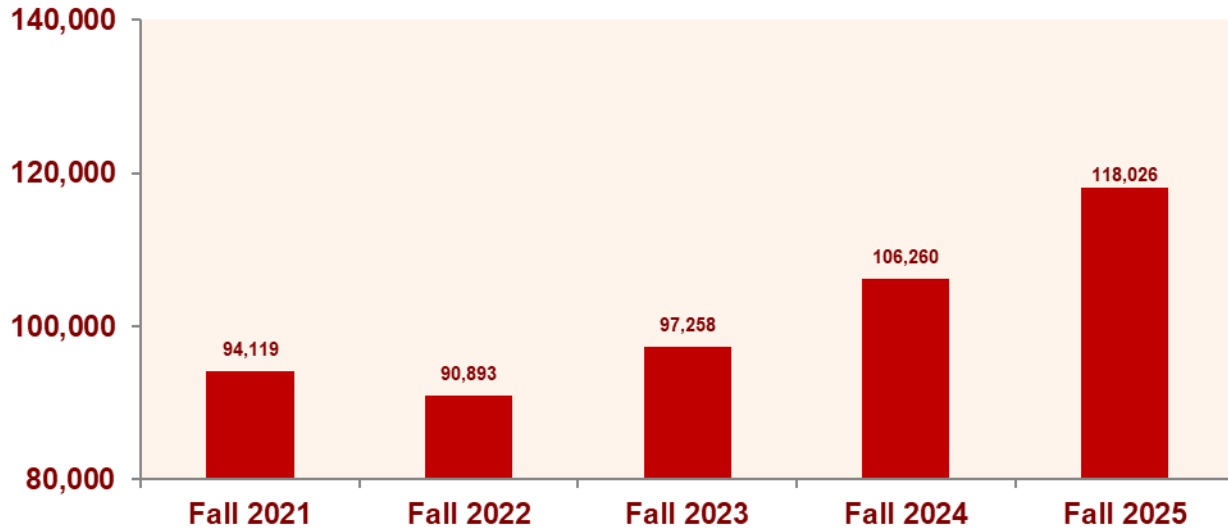

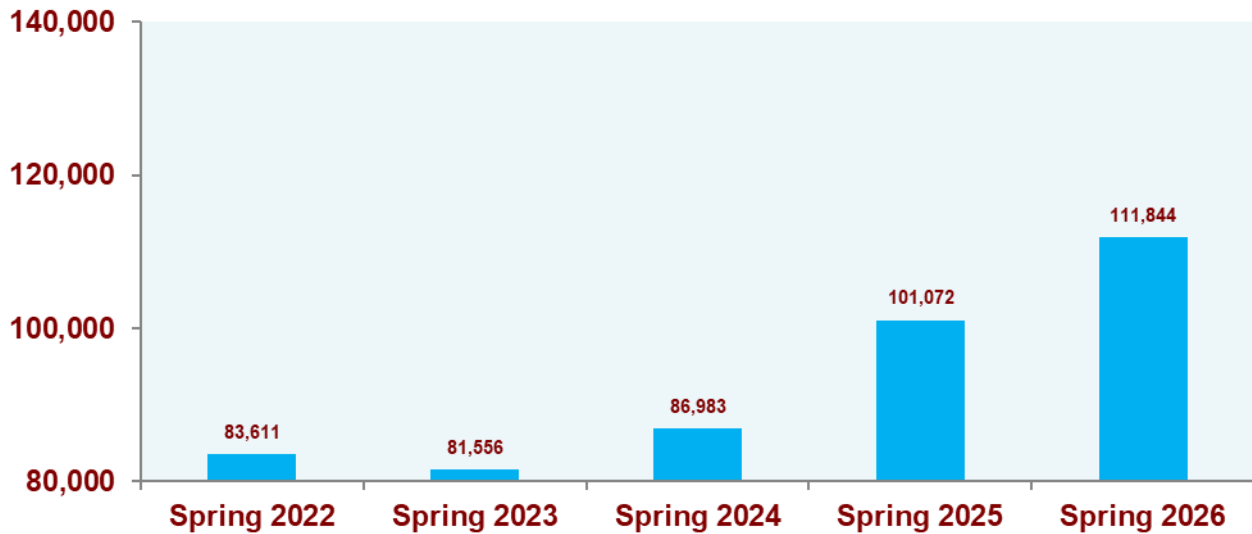
Total Student Credit Hours

Total Student Credit Hours

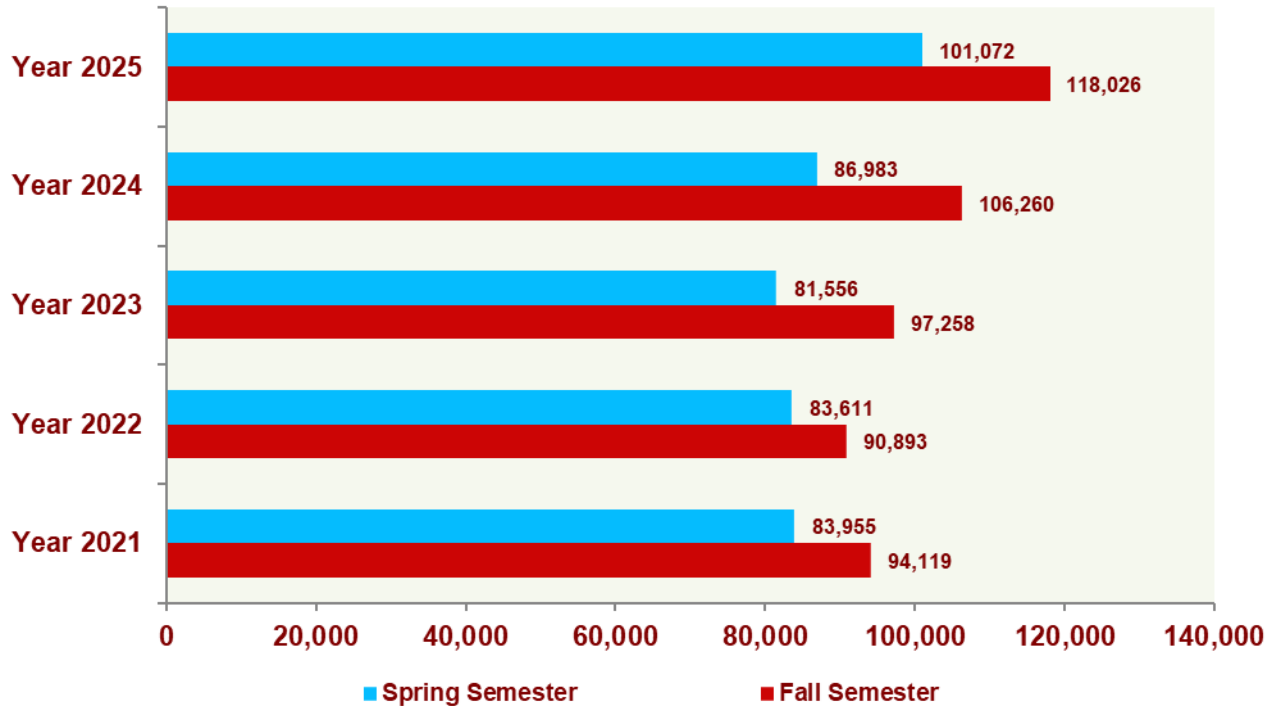

Total Student Credit Hours from Fall 2021 and Fall 2025



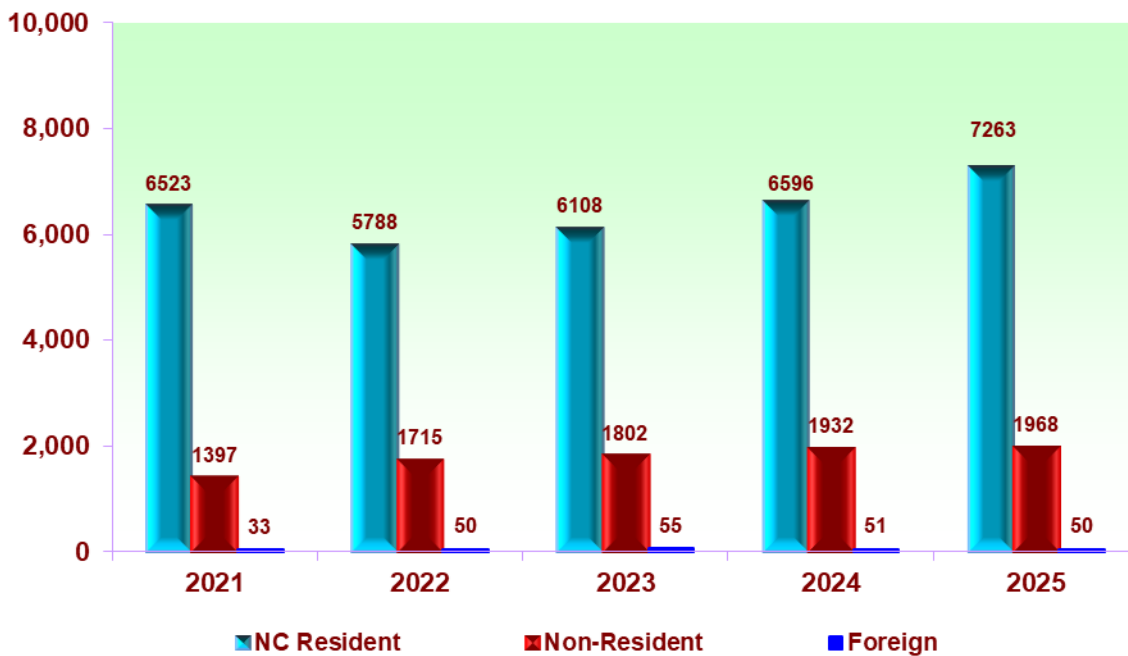

Fall 2021 – 2025



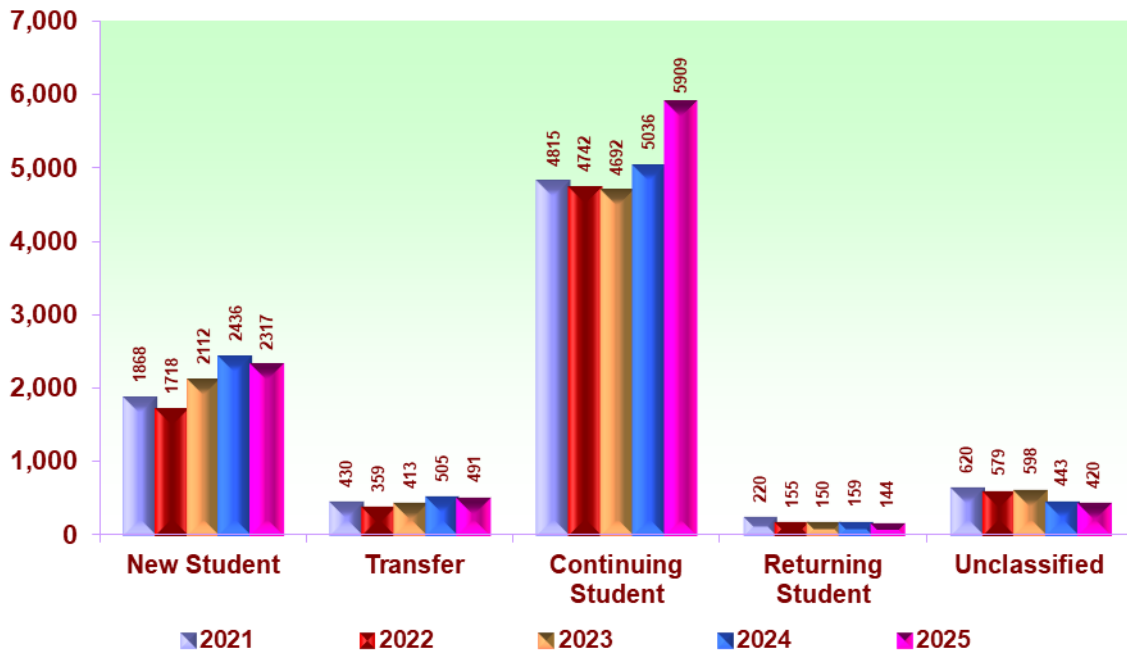
