Three-Year Track Course Sequence

Students who have not completed all of the prerequisite courses can be admitted to the CSD Program. However, a student who has not completed each prerequisite course prior to enrollment should expect their timeframe for graduation to be extended. A student without a background will generally follow the course sequence below his or her first year in the graduate program before beginning required graduate coursework. With the exception of Aural Rehabilitation, each prerequisite course (see Section 3.2) must be completed before a student can enroll in clinical practicum. Students with a partial background must consult their advisors to determine the appropriate course sequence.
