

Submit an EHS Hazard and Incident Report Form to request a visual growth assessment if any of the following conditions exist:

- \square Visible growth inside.
- □ Consistent moldy or musty smells within a building.
- ☐ Known episodes of major leaks or flooding.

 \rightarrow MOLD is a common term used to refer to fungal growth.

 \rightarrow MOLD can be found on \rightarrow MOLD spores are almost any organic substance as long as water and oxygen are present.

naturally occurring and can never be prevented completely from finding a place to grow.

 \rightarrow MOLD exposure does not always present a health problem but sensitive persons can experience allergic reactions.

No EPA or other federal limits have been set for mold or mold spores.
