The Evolving Landscape of Employment Law in the Era of Artificial Intelligence

The symposium on The Evolving Landscape of Employment Law in the Era of Artificial Intelligence offers an in-depth look at how AI is transforming the world of work and the legal frameworks that govern it.

This event is designed to address the critical legal, ethical, and regulatory challenges that arise as artificial intelligence becomes increasingly embedded in employment practices.

While employers have at their disposal many applications and automated solutions to help them with making employment decisions such as hiring, firing, promotion or discipline; using these applications and automated solutions does not shield employers from potential violations of employment discrimination laws, such as Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, American with Disabilities Act, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act.

Attendees will explore the rapidly changing patchwork of federal, state, and local laws regulating Al in hiring, promotion, and workplace management. The symposium will focus on the legal risks and compliance obligations associated with Al-driven employment decisions, including the growing requirements for bias audits, impact assessments, and transparency in automated decision-making systems. Special attention will be given to how these developments affect both employers and employees, with an emphasis on preventing discrimination, protecting privacy, and ensuring fairness for all workers.

The symposium will bring together legal scholars, policymakers, and labor advocates and will underscore the importance of equity, transparency, and accountability in the deployment of AI in employment. Our goal is to inform best practices and policy recommendations that advance justice and inclusion as AI continues to reshape the workplace.
