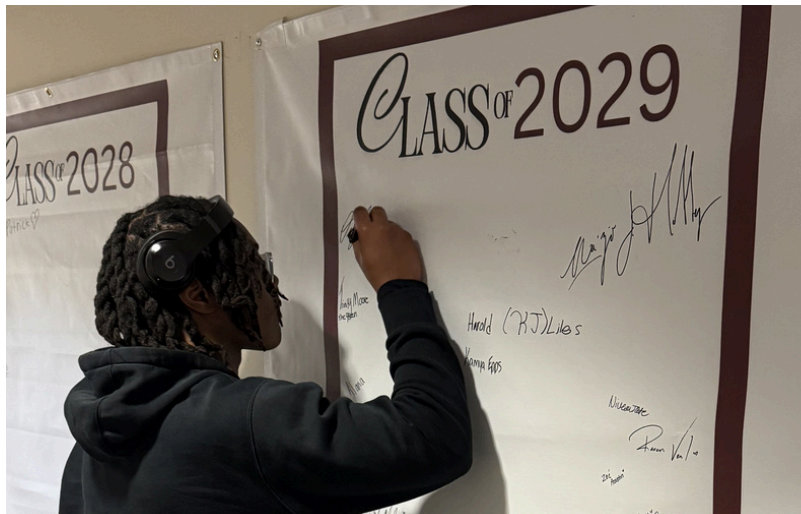

AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GPA

This matches the record for average cumulative GPA for all student athletes in the fall semester. All 13 sports, plus Varsity Cheerleading, have an average cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Women's and Men's Tennis both finished with average cumulative GPAs above 3.70.
