Respond to Your Offer

Submit your intent to enroll **within 14 days of receiving your decision letter**. You will receive an email with your next steps after submission.

Pay Your Enrollment Deposit

A **\$100 enrollment deposit** is the first required step on your checklist and is required to activate access to class registration, financial aid, your NCCU email account, and other student services.

The deposit is submitted through the application portal at gradapply.nccu.edu after you have been accepted and have confirmed your intent to enroll.

NCCU Account Setup

Within 48–72 hours of admission, please visit your dashboard to access your myEOL account information, including your NCCU email and password details. If it has been more than 72 hours since you were admitted and you are unable to access your account, please contact the NCCU IT Department for assistance.

Registration Credentials

Banner ID: Your unique student identification number used for all NCCU accounts.

Registration PIN: A required pin needed for course registration. May only be provided by your advisor at an advisory meeting; changes each semester.

Timeline: All Banner IDs and pins are sent to your academic department within one week of your decision letter.

Important Note

The **School of Graduate Studies** cannot release your registration PIN. You must meet with your advisor or academic department to obtain it.
